

1st person or 3rd person?

1st person point-of-view: the narrator is a character in the story (fiction or non-fiction)

Clues: I, me, our, us, myself, etc.

Example: autobiography

3rd person point-of-view: narrator is not a character in the story (fiction or non-fiction)

Clues: she, he, him, her, them, they, etc.

Example: biography

3rd person omniscient: narrator is all-knowing (know the thoughts of 2+ characters)

3rd person limited: narrator is not all-knowing (knows the thoughts of only 1 character)
